Mother's Day Dessert Crepe



MATERIALS

- 4 eggs, slightly beaten
- 1 1/3 cups milk
- 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Fruit
- Whipped topping
- Ice cream

DIRECTIONS

1. In large bowl, whisk together eggs, milk, melted butter, flour sugar and salt until smooth.
2. Heat a medium-sized skillet or crepe pan over medium heat. Grease pan with a small amount of butter or oil applied with a brush or paper towel. Using a serving spoon or small ladle, spoon about 3 tablespoons crepe batter into hot pan, tilting the pan so that bottom surface is evenly coated. Cook over medium heat, 1 to 2 minutes on a side, or until golden brown.
3. Sprinkle warm crepes with sugar and lemon, or serve with cream or ice cream and fruit.

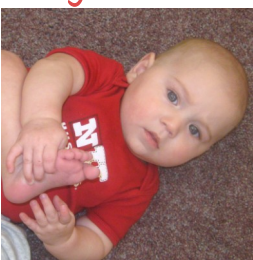
Notes to Parents

* Miss Angie's last day will be Friday, May 20th. She is returning to her hometown of Hastings to finish her Bachelors in Elementary Education from Hastings College.

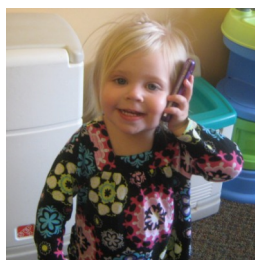
* Our newsletters will now be displayed in the classrooms, online and by the time clock. They will no longer be sent home. Thank you!

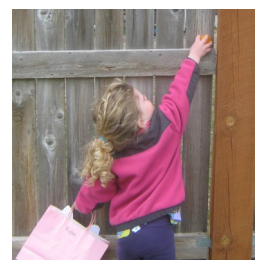


Adrian loves playing with his feet.
